

English Translation of the Greek Original

Report of Factual Findings in Connection with Agreed Upon Procedures

To the Board of Directors of the Union
Transparency International Greece

In accordance with the request of the Board of Directors of “Transparency International Greece” (the Union) we have performed the procedures enumerated below with respect to the income and expense statements relating to the 13th International Anti-Corruption Conference, as set out in the attached tables 1 and 2, which was organized, on behalf of the Union, by AC&C (the Company) . Our engagement was undertaken in accordance with the International Standard on Related Services (ISRS 4400) applicable to agreed – upon procedures engagements. The procedures were performed are summarized as follows:

- 1) Ensuring that appropriate supporting documentation exists for the expenses included in the statement prepared by AC & C list, (table 1), in order to verify that the expense was properly recorded and that it related to the conference.
- 2) Ensuring that appropriate supporting documentation exists for income included in the statement prepared by AC & C (table 2).

We report our findings below:

- 1) With respect to item 1 above, from our review of the supporting documents relating to expenses of a total value Euro 2 150 588,87 including VAT, with the statement provided by the Company , table 1, we noted the following:

We verified that the expenses with supporting documentation such as invoices, receipts, etc., were properly recorded and that they related to the Conference.

We verified that the remuneration of the Company which organized the Conference was properly recorded and that it was calculated in accordance with the signed agreement between the Company and the Union.

The Other expenses of Euro 19 877,70 include an amount of Euro 8 043,21 that relates to bank commissions for credit card charges of the Conference participants. Considering the volume of credit card transactions and the commission rates agreed between the respective banks and the Company the amount seems to be reasonable. Moreover, the Other expenses

includes an amount of Euro 11 834,49 that concerns VAT for expenses that will be invoiced to Transparency International Greece with a VAT rate 19%.

- 2) With respect to item 2 above, from our review of the supporting documentation for the income of a total value Euro 576 943, 00 including VAT, with the statement provided by the Company ,table 2, we noted the following:

We ensured that the income from sponsorships agree to both the invoices issued by the Company, and to either the sponsors' decisions for the payments of the sponsorship or the sponsorship contracts.

Because the above procedures do not constitute either an audit or a review made in accordance with International Standards on Auditing or International Standards on Review Engagements, we do not express any other assurance apart from those specified above.

Had we performed additional procedures or had we performed an audit or review of the financial statements other matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported to you, apart from those specified above.

This report is solely addressed to the Board of Directors of the Union and is for the purpose for your information for the income and expenses of the 13th conference. Therefore this report is not to be used for other purposes, as it only extends to the items specified above.
